

CCA Provides Hernando County Notice of Termination of Management Contract for Hernando County Jail

NASHVILLE, TN, Apr 28, 2010 (MARKETWIRE via COMTEX) --CCA (Corrections Corporation of America) (NYSE: CXW), the nation's largest partnership corrections provider to government agencies, announced today that it has provided notice of its intent to terminate the management contract for the 876-bed Hernando County Jail. As required under the agreement, CCA has provided Hernando County 120-day notice of termination and expects to turn over operations of the facility to the new operator on or about August 26, 2010.

Damon Hininger, president and CEO, stated, "The decision was not easy for CCA given the partnership it has had with Hernando County for nearly 20 years, but is necessary given the continuing poor financial performance at the facility. CCA will work with the County to ensure a smooth and effective transition to the new operator."

CCA currently operates 65 facilities, including 44 company-owned facilities, with a total design capacity of approximately 87,000 beds in 19 states and the District of Columbia. These services are intended to reduce recidivism and to prepare inmates for their successful re-entry into society upon their release. CCA also provides health care (including medical, dental and psychiatric services), food services and work and recreational programs.
